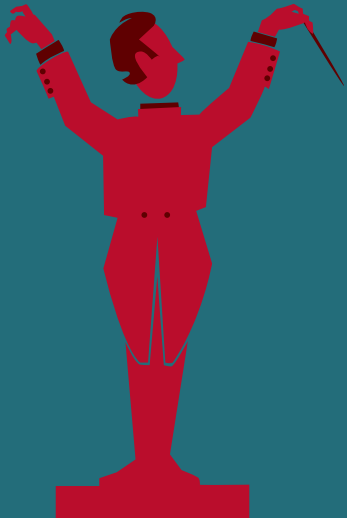


## MISSION
